In addition, you not only provided the opportunity for the students to live with dignity, but also their children and wider families as well.


I have listed below, for your information, a summary report of the outcomes of the 170 students who graduated from the Bankura VTC in June last year and what they were doing at end March 2006.

- 122 students are working in the job they got when they graduated.
- 25 (21 female) are doing further training to help ensure that they get sustainable employment.
- 18 students have left their original employment to go to another employer.
- 5 students have never worked in the area of work that they trained in.

In closing, may I again say thank you to you and your Company for your encouragement and compassionate support for the work of The Leprosy Mission, in not only raising money for the Bankura VTC, but in helping to raise the profile of the work of The Mission in Australia and overseas.

I look forward to meeting with you next week and sharing with you in the work of The Leprosy Mission again during 2006.
